TBSI offers assistance to faculty and researchers applying for Shenzhen Government-sponsored talent plans and other Shenzhen high-level talents plans that offer allowances of up to 3,000,000 RMB.

Each lab will be supported by one secretary and one technician.

Student and postdoctoral recruitment

If applicable, faculty members may apply for TBSI-funded researchers (typically one postdoctoral fellow, one doctoral student, and several master students).

Qualifications:

- Applicants must hold a doctorate or equivalent degree.
- Research experience across various fields and institutions is strongly preferred.
- Members of the Thousand Youth Talents Plan or the Thousand Talents Plan are especially favorably regarded.
- Ideally, candidates should be able to demonstrate strong communication, teaching and leadership skills in English as well as the ability to actively contribute to the rapidly growing research efforts at TBSI.
- A strong commitment to teaching and supervising postgraduate students is essential. Teaching responsibilities will include participating in and developing graduate courses, and strong engagement with TBSI's core curriculum. Supervision

of PhD and MSc students and academic advising of trainees at all levels are also expected.
