The Baker Institute is Australia's first multidisciplinary institute dedicated tackling cardiovascular disease, diabetes, obesity and metabolic disorders. With over 360 staff and graduate students, and a history spanning more than 90 years, the Institute is internationally renowned for its high quality translational research output encompassing cellular and molecular biology, pre-clinical and clinical research, epidemiology, public health and health services research.
