


SAMPLING THE SPIN-OFF SPIRIT


Q1. Which of the below entrepreneurial activities have you ever undertaken? (Select all that apply)









Q3. Would you consider, or have you any intention, of starting a spin-off company using your research that may require you to leave academia?




Q4. What do you believe are the key motivators that people have for leaving academia to start their own spin-off business? (Select up to three)




Q5. What do you believe are the main barriers that discourage scientists from leaving academia to start a spin-off business? (Select up to three)
